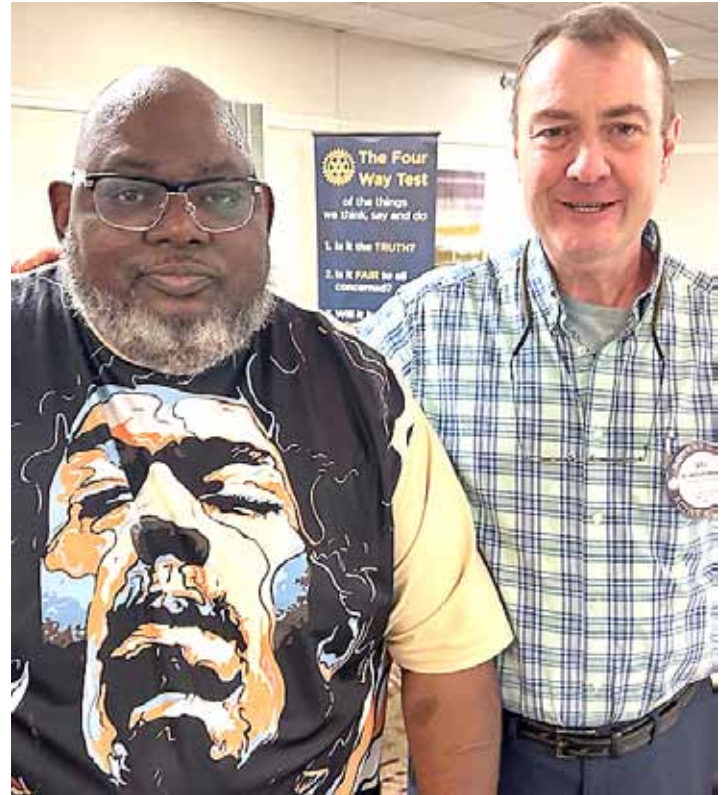

Rotarians on July 19.

King never gives up, and thousands of children in the Quad Cities are beneficiaries of his actions.

King, who founded the organization in 2016 when he saw children being bullied for having holes in their shoes, talked about the upcoming 9th annual shoes and coats giveaway on Sunday, Sept. 22, from 2 to 5 p.m. at the Martin Luther King Jr. Center in Rock Island.

An estimated 1,000 new pairs of shoes, and coats, will be distributed that day, along with winter hats, mittens and socks. The event will also feature free haircuts and hair stylings for children, food and entertainment.

The event is open to any child in the Quad Cities. Parents must be present with the child in order to receive shoes and a coat.

King said the 2023 event was a big success, serving 750 children, and he thanked sponsors and volunteers. More than 56 Quad City businesses are working to support and donate funds, coats, shoes or provide other assistance to the program.

New sponsors and volunteers are always needed, King said. Call 309-292-3210 for information on getting involved.

Though he suffers from a rare disease – Stiff Person Syndrome – which attacks all the muscles in the body and makes movement very difficult, King said, “It’s not about me; it’s about the children.”

“It’s been tough for all the people,” he said. “Don’t ever give up.”

King has been honored by Servpro and TV6 as a “Home-town Hero” for his service to children in the Quad Cities.

## ROTARY PRINCIPLES

### The Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- FIRST:** The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- SECOND:** High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- THIRD:** The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
- FOURTH:** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

### Rotary Code of Conduct

**As a Rotarian, I will:**

1. Exemplify the core value of integrity in all behavior and activities.
2. Use my vocational experience and talents to serve Rotary.
3. Conduct all my personal, business, and professional affairs ethically, encouraging and fostering high ethical standards as an example for others.
4. Be fair in all dealings with others and treat them with the respect due to them as fellow human beings.
5. Promote recognition and respect for all occupations which are useful to society.
6. Offer my vocational talent to provide opportunities for young people, to work for the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community.
7. Honor the trust that Rotary and fellow Rotarians provide and not do anything that will bring disfavor or reflect adversely on Rotary or fellow Rotarians.
8. Not seek from a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.

3. Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
