## POLIO: ROTARY'S NO. 1 GOAL

### Dear Rotarian Polio Eradication Warriors,

One new Wild Polio case reported this week. We are now 3 weeks since the Onset of Paralysis of the most recent reported Wild Polio Case in Afghanistan.

Gaza (occupied Palestinian territory) - The Israeli military and Palestinian militant group Hamas have begun three separate, zoned three-day Polio Vaccination Pauses in the Gaza Strip. Rotary has donated \$500,000 to the effort and the UAE has pledged an additional \$5 million. The vaccination campaign started in central Gaza on Sunday, September 1 with a higher than expected 187,000 children vaccinated over the first three days. See a video here:

Delivery of vaccines in conflict areas is always difficult. To protect children and prevent further spread of the virus, UNICEF is attempting to deliver more than 1.2 million doses of the Novel Oral Polio Vaccine Type 2 to Gaza, and thousands more are on the way, in an effort to protect over 640,000 children under the age of 10.
