PROGRAM RECAP

Matt Lindaman and Ken Brockman, ORA Orthopedics and Physical Therapy

Tracy Lindaman provides introduction including a personal testimony for joint replacement, and professes that Mr. Lindaman "Owes all personal and professional success to his loving and supportive wife."

Ken Brockman has been affiliated with ORA since 2009. The ORA network currently includes 27 physicians, several NP and PA's, 60 PT', and 550 total employees across 4 clinics. The network saw 30,000 patients in 2024.

The most recent developments include groundbreaking of a new office in Bettendorf proximate to the BettPlex, with an estimated grand opening date of February 2026. Initial discussions regarding the new facility began in February 2021, marking a 5-year timeline from initial concept to project completion. The new facility boasts 60,000 square feet of office space over 2 stories with over 100 rooms including 2 procedure rooms, 12 short stay rooms, 42 pre- and post-op bays, 50 exam rooms, 4 MRI units, a surgery center, weight bearing CT scanners, and a therapy pool.

The new facility provides overall muscle and skeletal care and features an updated building design and process flows which account for recent trends in care. Mr. Brockman states that 80% of issues are genetic, rather than a result of environment, though he acknowledges that there may exist some upside in proximity to the BettPlex for athletic-related injuries.

Mr. Brockman discusses a rather significant shift in care protocol for joint replacement, stating that as recently as 15 years ago, 100% of surgical procedures were in-patient, with on-site recovery and therapy a part of the overall process. Estimates are that between 40-50% of current procedures are now outpatient, with that number expected to rise to 70% by 2030. Accounting for this dramatic shift, Mr. Brockman credits advances in anesthesia, surgical techniques, post-op procedures, especially related to pain control, as well as cost savings and related embrace of these processes on behalf of the insurance providers.
