

# Rotarian Action Groups Growing in Popularity and Impact

Since Rotarian Action Groups (RAGS) were first recognized by the Rotary International Board of Directors in 2005, their popularity and impact have grown around the world. In 2015-16, the 26 RAGs' combined membership was 37,606. with members from more than 100 countries. Excluding the Rotarian Action Group for Population & Development, which reported the largest membership of any group at 20,000 members, the average size for each RAG is around 704 members.

In 2015-16, RAGs reported a combined income of \$637,363 from membership dues, grants, and other charitable contributions. With the average annual membership cost of \$26. In 2015-16, the 26 RAGs reported spending \$561,793 on international humanitarian service projects and other activities. At year end, RAGs reported combined net assets of \$443,042.
