Our songs were God Bless America, Smiles and Take Me Out to the Ball Game.

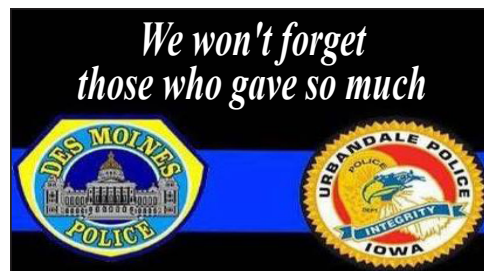
Ed Arnold was our sergeant and as usual was awesome!

Our presenter Bethany presented the findings of the Capital Crossroads vision to push central Iowa to dream big, not settle for good enough and to work for long term

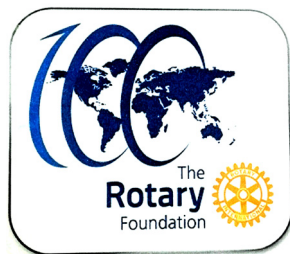
