
provided coats to Joppa's clients and extended a grant to the same organization. Working with an already chartered club, Heidi and Dennis founded the Rotary Club of Homeless Outreach, Prevention and Education ("HOPE").

There is plenty of information on their website regarding the Club of HOPE; briefly, the club meets 2x per month via Zoom (1st and 3rd Thursday) with two types of members – active and associate, meaning all Rotarians can easily participate in both meetings and service activities.

Club members strive to lead a dialogue that results in more positive outcomes, understanding that the first step in solving an issue like homelessness (which is being solved by organizations such as Joppa ad homeward Iowa) is to increase awareness and elevate the discourse.

There are plenty of "next steps": for example, HOPE members are currently establishing one Sunday a month during which we can join a team of Joppa volunteers on a route providing food and other essential items to the unsheltered. ZOOM into one of the next HOPE meetings to find out one of the many ways in which you also can help solve the issue of homelessness.


