Janet Fisher Mosaic

Our speaker on Friday was Janet Fisher, Resource Development Manger (e.g., fundraiser-in-chief) at Mosaic. Mosaic is a 501(c)(3) organization, and is the largest faith-based program (through the ELCA) in the country to specialize in residential services for adults with developmental disabilities. It operates in 11 states and Tanzania, with programs in seven counties in Iowa.

What is now Mosaic originated 106 years ago (1913) with the Bethphage Mission in Axtell, NE (now an NPS Historic Site), after Rev. K.G. Dahl, a minister traveling near there, saw a disabled man be horribly mistreated after suffering a seizure in public. In 2003, Bethphage merged with the Martin Luther Home in Sterling, NE (founded in 1925), to form the modern Mosaic program.

Mosaic believes that there is a life of possibilities beyond institutions. It specializes in residential services in the form



of group homes and host families - but not for clients who live with their own families, who are served by other programs and agencies. In central Iowa alone, Mosaic operates 31 homes, many of which are owned by Polk County. Mosaic clients are people who were diagnosed, prior to age 18, with intellectual disabilities, but Mosaic has recently also been approved to serve people who have suffered traumatic brain injuries.

Hard to pick favorites but here are a few that we have really enjoyed:


Here in the Des Moines area: Iowa State Capital, Science Center, The Warehouse, Events Center, Living
