Since those days, the company has rebranded itself, and been acquired by and become a subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway through Berkshire Hathaway Energy. It operates utility services in 18 states, Canada and the Philippines and has over 19,000 employees. It also has a division, Home Services of America, that provides real estate mortgage and brokerage services. Rotarian Helen Turner is one of their real estate brokers.

Hy-Vee Raffle Ticket Sales Saturday & Sunday - May 22 & 23 and May 29 & 30 energy were 70% coal, 19% natural gas, 11% nuclear and 0% wind. In 2020 those percentages are now 24% coal, 12% natural gas, 4% nuclear and 59% wind. Another fun fact, Iowa has the 13th lowest utility rates in the US.

MidAmerican, along with other Iowa-based utilities, wase hard hit by last summer's derecho. MidAmerican's response team totaled nearly 2,100 workers, and they restored service to nearly all their customers in less that 120 hours. And this most recent cold spell, which devastated part of Texas, also had an impact on Iowa utilities. The natural gas usage was up 50% from normal during the period of February 5th to the 18th. Tim did explain that their cost of acquiring natural gas also went up, but was lessened by their practice of protecting against spikes in price with long term contracts. He did estimate that the average increase in our natural gas cost/month will be about \$18.

MidAmerican is also investing in electric vehicle charging stations around the state. They currently have 18 locations and plan to add another 18 in 2021, and 14 in 2022.
