Your CBD Store



Father-daughter team Michael and Lacie own and operate several locations of the Your CBD Store, in Urbandale, Valley Junction, Ankeny, Sioux City and soon in Waukee. Their stores specialize in selling holistic products that utilize CBD, or cannabidiol compounds. [Researched by your Scribe: Cannabidiol is a phytocannabinoid discovered in 1940. It is one of 113 identified cannabinoids in cannabis plants, along with tetrahydrocannabinol [THC], and accounts for up to 40% of the plant's extract.] CBD is derived from the hemp plant, a relative of marijuana, but it does not contain THC at a hallucinogenic component level. Sales of hemp-based products have been legal at various levels under federal law since 2018, and in Iowa since 2019 and 2020.

Michael and Lacie explained that the human body generally knows what it needs, to be well. CBD products act on the endocannabidiol system in the human body (look it up on Wikipedia!), which is primarily a part of the nervous system, starting with receptors in the brain. CBD products are particularly useful in dealing with pain control, such as from fibromyalgia and arthritis. Because they help with pain control, they also improve sleep patterns. It can be sold in consumable form, such as oil, capsules, gummies and hard candies, or in creams and ointments for external application.
