Bob Rafferty - Energy Revolution

Bob Rafferty, the Executive Director of Iowa Business for Clean Energy (IBCE) described for the club the current regulatory environment for energy in the state and some of the inefficiencies born of that structure. The goal of IBCE is to have competitive energy for all Iowa businesses by 2040.

Currently, electric utilities operate in exclusive territories with rates

based on their capital investment. This structure served the industry well 100 years ago when it was new and building the production capacity and grid was imperative. Today the same regulations create inefficiencies because utilities' profits are driven by capital investment, they are also tasked with implementing programs to reduce demand. Utilities have incentives to build capacity to handle the peak 80-100 hours of every year, but little incentive to manage consumption to more effectively match production to demand.

With better regulatory policies, market incentives and innovation, Iowa can create an environment that increases renewable energy adoption, increases efficiency and drives down costs for businesses and residents. Iowans need to become more informed about the current regulatory structure and move towards one to create a more prosperous future.
