AJ who has been the City Manager for 37 years gave us the year in review:

City Hall closed March of last year. Business continued remotely and is slowly reopening.

Library has gone to curbside, virtual and limited in-person services.

Senior Center is reopening slower than other departments due to the vulnerability of the population it serves. It's the only city-run Senior Center in the state.

Parks and Recreation will start running programs and classes this summer.

A 56 million dollar budget was approved which included a 5-cent tax reduction.

Urbandale Pool closed and will not reopen as it was not financially sustainable, especially after closing for COVID.

Douglas Reconstruction Project includes road and trail work: a "Complete Street Project" which will provide designated lanes for bikes as well as pedestrians, in addition to repairing the road.

2020 was the best year for single family home permits. 2021 is projected to be just as good.

Continued city-wide awareness, preparedness, and safety from what we learned during this pandemic and to be ready for the future.

The second part of the program was provided by Aaron, who is the project lead on the Merle Hay Reinvestment District

Merle Hay was the first mall in the state (1959), but the landscape of retail has changed.

The Buccaneers are looking for a new facility.

This project is being planned in hopes of receiving state assistance for this 75-acre project for the "new" Merle Hay which includes:

- 1. A new 3,500 seat arena for the Buccaneers which includes 4 different ice areas.
- 2. 150 room hotel.
- 3. Renovated food court
- 4. New 80,000 square foot retail center.
- 5. An outlot project of retail providing Kohls a new 120,000 square foot building.
- 6. The Tower being renovated into senior housing.

The goal is to create a complete shopping AND entertainment center for the community. If all goes as planned, construction will start in Fall, 2021 and the "first puck" on ice in early 2022. Next steps is their presentation to the state.
