but do not provide a cure. Risk factors increasing the likelihood of being affected include age, family history, genetics, physical head injuries and overall heart health. Patients tend to live four to eight years after diagnosis, but can survive as long as twenty years with the disease. Alzheimer's is not a natural part of the aging process. More than 200,000 patients are under the age of 65. Finally, Latinos and African Americans are one-and-a-half times more likely to contract the disease.
