Dress a Girl Around the World

The August 10, 2018 meeting of the Rotary Club of Northwest Des Moines was very informative on several levels. Sergeant Mark McAndrews guizzed the group on what we learned last week from District Foundation Chair, Chris Knapp. Results were mixed! We discovered (were reminded) that our Club has some very interesting, active and talented members and spouses.

Our speaker, Rachel Cinader, founder of Dress a Girl Around the World, was introduced by Donna Moore, spouse of Rotarian Bob Moore.

Three years Donna ago, started a local "Dress a Girl" chapter, coordinating the sewing and dis-



tribution of t-shirt and pillow case dresses around the world. The charitable work has evolved into sewing dresses from patterns and teaching women in Ghana, Uganda, and Honduras how to sew using the ever popular Singer "treadle" machines. Ten years later, the Hope 4 Women International not only has provided over One Million dresses in 82 countries, but has begun to teach women in year-long programs to run their own businesses. The women are taught English, budgeting, and business ethics.
