Doyle Sanders - Rotary International



The topic of this week's program was the Rotary Foundation, presented by Club Foundation chair Doyle Sanders. The first part of the presentation dealt with various aspects of our Club's support over the years. We have given a total of \$682,647.80 and can rightfully brag on ourselves! We are currently a 100% club, which means we average each year at least \$100 per member in donations, qualifying for "every Rotarian every year." We also became a "100% Paul Harris Fellow" club a few years ago! Doyle additionally gave a breakdown of the various levels of giving by individual Club members over the years.

Handouts showing each member's Paul Harris status were then distributed. Doyle explained how Club points (as reflected in the handouts) are assigned, and how we may wish to use them. Members may keep those Club points for themselves, or donate them to other Club members, family, or friends. It was emphasized that decisions on these points should be made rather soon.


