Maddie who is a previous server at UGCC, came to speak to us about Interact. Interact is a high school club that works directly with a local Rotary club in projects that expose the youth to the 4 Way Test and Service Above Self. A senior at Valley High School and who is graduating in January, Maddie has been in the Interact club for 3 years. With Past District Governor Tom Narak as their Rotary sponsor from the DSM AM club, along with Mrs. Johnson their faculty advisor they have a very active club. The 10-15 members meet every other week on Tuesdays.

They are involved in small volunteer projects each month, with quarterly big projects that engage and encourage the members in Service Above Self. Projects like bike, coat and canned food drives, Meals from the Heartland, Adopt-a- Family during the holiday season and trips to Xicotepec Mexico are just some of the examples of projects this club has been involved in. All projects are funded and supported by the DSM AM Club. Maddie mentioned that the financial obligation along with finding both school and rotary sponsors to be directly involved in the club as an obstacle in starting new Interact clubs. Valley's Interact Club uses Club Star, which is a club fair, and the promise of Silver Cord hours to recruit new members.

On a personal note, Maddie has been involved in debate for 11 years and has "a passion for arguing". Growing up in West Des Moines, she credits her heart for service to her family that instilled volunteerism, faith, family, attitude, and ethics in her at a very young age. During COVID she did volunteer work through her church and has gone beyond the 50 hours for her Silver Cord and has earned a Gold Cord which takes 100 volunteer hours.
