### Rev. Sarai Rice

DM Area Religious Council

Sarai Schnucker Rice, Executive Director of DMARC (Des Moines Area Religious Council) is a graduate of Truman University and Yale Divinity School. Her speech to our Club provided us with insights into the organization and work of DMARC.

Ms. Rice indicated that DMARC is a very diverse organization. It's membership is made up of many different cultures and faiths in the City of Des Moines. The membership unites to provide services to those who find themselves short of the basic necessities of life, i.e., food, rent & utility assistance and child care.

DMARC has several Food Pantries throughout the metropolitan area of DesMoines. Food pantries are the primary service that DMARC offers.

Food is supplied to the pantries through donations from various grocery stores. individuals and cash donations.

Forty percent of the clients of DMARC are eligible for Food Stamps, but have not signed up for the program. DMARC encourages these clients to sign up for SNAP, the Federal Food Stamp program. The client is provided a food stamp card, similar to a debit card, They can use this card at grocery stores and at the farmers market.

Ms. Rice indicted that DesMoines citizens are very generous in donating money and food. DMARC has experienced a significant increase in clients in 2010. In 2010 they served 10,000 families and 30,000 people and the trend is continuing up-ward. Ms. Rice gave high praise to the operation of the Urbandale Food Pantry, which is affiliated with DMARC.

Linda Ennen was awarded the Lepley Hero in Education award. A check for \$500 will be given to her school for supplies she needs.




