January is Rotary Awareness Month. The public is aware of Rotary but the majority of them are unsure of what we do. An average of 62% of non-Rotarians recognize the Rotary name, but of those, only 37% have some familiarity with what Rotary does. This is according to the results of a 2010 public image survey Rotary International commissioned of about 1,000 people in each of six countries-Argentina, Australia, Germany, Japan, South Africa and the United States.

In the US 34% of the people surveyed had no awareness of Rotary at all, 29% were aware of Rotary, but not familiar with what we do and 37% had some familiarity.

Joe Murdock Merle Hay Mall

Our speaker, Joe Murdock, assumed the role of General Manager of the Merle Hay Mall this past year. He grew up in Utah and managed properties in several different states before moving to Des Moines.

The Mall was built as an outdoor mall by Joseph Abell in 1959 and has been continuously owned since by his family. The headquarters is in Chicago, and the firm owns only one other property, in Toledo, Ohio. The site had been home to St. Gabriel's monastery from 1921 until 1928. After construction, the mall was named for Merle Hay, the first Iowan, and possibly the first American killed in World War I. In 1972 the mall was enclosed, and two years later it was expanded.

There was a terrible fire in Younkers in November 1978. Ten people lost their lives in that fire, and it took nearly a year for the store to be rebuilt.

The department stores own their own sites, while the smaller firms lease from the mall. Some of the businesses, such as Hickory Farms, are operated as specialties, open only at certain times of the year. Many are "mom and pop" retailers, and the mall management works with these firms, helping to incubate these new businesses.

Some interesting facts about the Merle Hay Mall:

- It includes the largest movie theater in Iowa
- The basement, which now has only the bowling alley, once held several other businesses and was designed with thick walls, to be a refuge in case of attack by the Soviet Union
- The Red Rock Wildlife Education Center at the mall contains many exotic animals, including wolves, bobcats, a coyote and a raccoon.
- The Iowa Reptile Rescue and Education Center, coming next summer will include snakes and other reptiles
- Part of the mall is in Urbandale and part is in Des Moines.
