Established in 1987, Consumer Credit of Des Moines is a non-profit credit counseling service dedicated to helping families find peace of mind through money management and debt reduction. Consumer Credit of Des Moines provides free and confidential financial counseling, and a debt repayment program to pay off debts in a systematic, respectable manner.

Since 1987, Mr. Coates has observed changes in credit card use and personal savings habits. In 1987 Americans on the average had 2 to 3 credit cards; by 2008 the average American had 8 to 10 credit cards. In 1987 the average American saved 7.3% of his/her income; by 2008 the average American had a negative savings, excluding retirement funds.

Mr. Coates handed out a brochure that included the following warning signs of a debt problem:

- Having required monthly payments to creditors total 20% or more of take home income (not including rent or mortgage).
- Using savings for daily expenses.
- Using cash advances from credit card issuers to pay other creditors and/or daily expenses.
- Paying the minimum amount due on your bills or LESS each month.
- Not knowing how much you owe.
- Receiving calls or letters from creditors due to not paying on time.
- Fighting in the home due to money problems.
- Experiencing creditor's law suits, repossessions or garnishment of wages.
