#### A Song is worth a Thousand Words

Friday's guest was a soprano singing phenomenon! Leanne Freeman-Miller, an associate professor of voice at Drake University, gave a wonderful performance that had the entire Rotary spellbound by her talent. Leanne was born and raised in Estherville, Iowa. She completed her bachelor's degree in music education at the University of South Dakota and a master's degree in vocal performance from Drake University, where she has been a member of the music faculty for 15 years.

In 2006 she received the Madelyn Levitt Teacher of the Year award, which is Drake's highest honor awarded to faculty for teaching. She has performed in several locations including performing in the Shanghai, China area in 2009. She teaches 40 students a week and many of them have gone on to be known as formidable in voice competitions and have won many national competitions. She says her students go into music "because it chooses you, you can't live without it."
