Science Center of Iowa

The Science Center of Iowa will be celebrating its 40th anniversary October 9, said Chris Beck, SCI Marketing Director. He added that the SCI is one of the oldest science centers (not museum) in the world.

SCI has the following mission:

- Encourages life ling learning
- Emphasizes NOT what but HOW to learn
- Strives to engage and inspire as a community resource

The Science Center of Iowa currently has six interactive experience platforms, 150 hands on activities, 7,000 hours of scheduled programming and over 12,000 COSMIC JUKEBOX shows have been created.

It also boasts the only domed IMAX theatre in the state. The Blank IMAX theatre is 6 stories high and shows not only documentaries but also Hollywood blockbuster movies.

Also housed in the SCI is the Iowa Learning Center that has been visited by over 80,000 high school students and the SCI preschool that can accommodate up to 150 students annually.

New for this fall at the SCI is DA VINCI, the genius. The 14,000 sq. ft. exhibit is the largest exhibit the SCI has had as yet and it will run Oc. 2
