

Don Patterson

District Governor

District Governor Don Patterson made his official visit to our club, accompanied by his wife Becky, who is also a Rotarian. He began his presentation by mentioning that this was his forty-fourth club visit, and the fourth one this week! Terming his remarks a "low-tech" presentation, he began by referring to last winter's International Assembly, where all 532 incoming governors received intensive training. He commented on then-incoming international president Kalvan Banerjee's speech to that group, in which the following strengthening family, were stressed: continuing what we do best, and being ready for change.

DG Patterson proceeded to tie in our district's numerous club and district projects, and named several. (He pointed out that he joined Rotary in 1974 simply as a condition of employment. Having since been in five different clubs, it was not until 1999 - when he became club president - that he actually began to learn more about district and international

activities!) He talked in particular about our district's involvement with the various Xicotepec, Mexico projects (in which several of our own club members have participated). They began with work in sanitation and health at the elementary school level, and have since expanded. He mentioned especially clean water, deworming medication, and fluoride painting. He referred also to the Guatemala MOST project and the water and sanitation project in Nigeria. All of these activities are samples of what RI is internationally!

He concluded by stressing that each Rotarian has his/her own way of participating, and that this is O.K. A short question and answer period followed.
