### Hearing

About 278 million people around the world have lost most or all of their hearing in both ears. The World Health Organization estimates that half the cases of deafness and hearing impairment world-wide can be prevented through early diagnosis and treatment. In the United States, more than 35 million children and adults live with some degree of hearing loss. Of those, more than 22 million between the ages of 20 and 69 have permanent damage. For at least 90 percent of people with hearing impairments, hearing aids result in improved communication.

However, unlike eyeglasses, which can often restore 20/20 vision, hearing aids do not return hearing to normal. According to the World Health Organization, less than 3% of people in developing countries who are in need of a hearing aid have one.
