These contributions will help Rotary raise \$200 million to match \$355 million in challenge grants received from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. The resulting \$555 million will directly support immunization campaigns in developing countries, where polio continues to infect and paralyze children, robbing them of their futures and compounding the hardships faced by their families.

Nancy Johnson introduced Del Christiansen, Executive Director of IRIS, Inc. Del, a visiting Rotarian from Adel Club has been with Iowa Resource for International Service since 2003. IRIS was founded as a peace institute in 1993 by Former Iowa Lieutenant Governor Bob Anderson. IRIS is a nonprofit, non-religious organization located in Ames that has since transformed into an focused organization on promoting international peace and understanding by hosting several cultural exchange programs that bring visitors to Iowa, as well as special programs that send Iowans abroad.

The program has brought 1,100 visitors to Iowa. They live with host families that hope to share ideas that they can take back home. IRIS, through the Youth Exchange and Study program has hosted high school students where the students participate in community service. Other programs include women in government (Women in Nigeria - WiN WiN Leadership Project), women entrepreneurs (two groups from South Africa), peace education for teachers from Southern Sudan, minority rights program Republic of Georgia, and citizen dialog groups from Ukraine.

In summary, a major objective is to provide participants skills to make their home community and country a better place. Volunteers and contributions are welcome.
