

Bill Riley

Today's program was arranged by Vicki Foresman and she was very pleased to introduce Bill Riley as the speaker. Bill shared with us some of the facts and stories concerning his father Bill Riley, Sr. who is widely known for the Iowa Talent Program that he began 54 years ago. Bill relayed to us some the interesting information that his father basically developed his career first in newspaper business and then went on into both radio and television. His father wrote a book in his late 70's that gave some information concerning his life but a second book was started later that contains more of a historical account particularly concerning the Talent Program and the Iowa State Fair. The title of the book is Sixty Years on the Air and at the Fair. In preparing this book his dad had handwritten notes and began to work on the computer a little when he was in his 80's but passed away in December of 2005 before the book was completed. The book traces Bill Senior's career and contains some of the following information:

Newspaper years -- He left the army in 1943 with a bad knee. While in the army he was an MP with a height of 5 ft. and 4 ¾ inches. He went to work at the US Department of Agriculture in the public relations department. Radio -- in the late 40's he went to work for what became known as KRNT as a news editor and sports reporter. On Sunday's he read the comics over the radio with Cloris Leachman, another well-known Iowan. While in radio he started working with variety shows with kids on the "Hey Bob Show" which stands for "be on the beam" and was a safety program. Television -- He moved on to television and was at the State Fair in 1946 when the first TV arrived there. His first television spot came in 1955 with what is now KCCI and included local programming that included such shows as Teen Time, the Breakfast Club and the Zoo Show.

Bill Junior took over the Iowa Talent Program 14 years ago after spending several years of his life in the construction industry.
