The Krause Challenge

John Rozycki explained to the Rotarians at our March 23rd meeting the annual investment competition among four Iowa universities: Drake University, Iowa State University, the University of Iowa, and the University of Northern Iowa. The competition was established through the generosity of Mr. W. A. "Bill" Krause founder of one of the nation's leading convenience store chains, Kum & Go, as a means of providing undergraduate students with real-world portfolio management experience. In 1998, Bill Krause of Krause Gentle Corporation (Kum & Go) endowed each of the four universities with \$100,000, establishing the Krause Challenge Fund.

The Drake University Krause Challenge fund is part of Drake University's endowment, and is managed under the auspices of Finance 190 (Equity Valuation and Analysis), which is open to senior finance majors. The course and challenge provide undergraduate students with real-world stock selection experiences. Throughout the semester, students analyze companies one at a time from inside out and upside down, they understand not only how the company performs financially today but also its history of performance, and predict how it will perform in the future. After analyzing Iowa companies, the students debate and make selection as to the companies whose stock they will purchase for the competition.

Given the nature of this course, enrollment is limited with only 13 of the 30 students applying to take the course this year being accepted.

For those students, the Krause Challenge has given them the opportunity to invest real money and experience the competitive environment of the financial world.


