Dennis GoldfordDrake University Professor

Professor Dennis Goldford teaches in the areas of political theory and constitutional law at Drake University. He specializes his research in the field of constitutional theory which is foremost reporting in our daily media concerning the controversial issues facing our country today.

His educational path commenced with the University of Michigan, ending with Oxford University and the University of Chicago where he obtained his M.A, and Ph.D. His studies have given him an in depth look at the historical formations of our Political Parties and how our country has arrived at where we are at today. The major events and demographics of our country with the news media that uses emotion to influence citizens voting decisions will make the Election of 2012 a crucial event that will shape our

national policies. He spoke at great length of the ebb and flow of the political power in the United States and the trend of the Republican Party that it has shifted to the right.

Professor Goldford is a nationally known author and global media analyst. He has written 3 books in the past 7 years with his latest book, The Constitution of Religious Freedom: God, Politics, and the First Amendment released this spring. You may also know him from appearing on our local stations giving his insightful and informative breakdown of current political events.

Professor Goldford has shared his ongoing research regarding our American political system with many in our community such as ours and we thank him for a thought-provoking presentation.
