The Future Vision Plan is The Rotary Foundation's new grant model to support club and district humanitarian and educational projects.

The Foundation Trustees identified a growing need to focus efforts in order to achieve greater impact, more public recognition, and streamlined operations for improved efficiency. The new grant structure will enable Rotarians to change people's lives, make the world a better place, and help meet the priorities and goals of Rotary's strategic plan.

A three-year pilot began in July 2010, with 100 Rotary districts testing the plan. All districts will

transition to the new model in July 2013.

Under Future Vision, the Foundation offers two types of grants. District grants are block grants that enable clubs and districts to address immediate needs in their communities and abroad. Global grants offer opportunities to participate in

strategically focused, high-impact activities within the six areas of focus. Global grants range from \$30,000 to \$400,000.

Lepley Scholarships

Roger Nyberg presented our awards for this year.

Brenda Auxier-Mailey introduced the winner of the Ken Lepley Memorial Hero in Education Award, **Cale Roe**. Cale teaches at-risk students in the Urbandale High School. He provides or helps find support for students in academic, interpersonal relationship challenges, substance abuse, and other areas that can interfere with a student's ability to prosper and succeed. He has spearheaded a program for prior drop-outs to finish their education through an off-site study p[program. In addition to the plaque give to Cale, the school will received a cash award to apply to supplies for Cale's programs.

Our award for non-traditional students – those not pursuing a standard 4-year college program – went to **Alisa Ward** from Urbandale HS. Alisa will be attending the Culinary Arts Program at DMACC. She has already participated in this program for two years, and hopes to study this summer in France.

Or traditional scholarship, which is based on both need and academics, went to **Meagan Dodd**, from Urbandale HS. She plans to attend Iowa State and study Psychology, and possibly certification as a public school teacher.

Roger noted that 6 of 12 applicants for the academic scholarship had a GPA of 4 or better!
