Sarah Bidney PGA: Learning Golf

Sarah Bidney, Golf Pro at Sugar Creek in Waukee, came with golf equipment and gave information about group and individual golf lessons.

She had worked at Otter Creek prior to going through the process to become a PRO. Her ventures took her to Florida, Utah and then she returned to the Des Moines area in 2008. To become a pro there are three levels: skill (36 holes below a specific cut score), the business end (development of a portfolio), and the people skills. There are "off months" in October through December, but planning is always taking place for the following season. Last year, she planned and then implemented this year, a Jr. Golf Team...complete with bags, t-shirts and schedule. She reports being pleased with this new concept.

Sarah is on staff with Calloway and suggests at least once, to get "fit" for clubs to determine the appropriate length and type of shaft on the clubs that fits your need and skill level.

One of the demonstrations she did involved swinging a club upside down to listen for the "whoosh." This shows you where the greatest force is. Hearing the sound before the ball or after the ball would indicate less torque on impact. This was a type of drill that you can do at home in the living room.
