# Theresa Bomhof

Nat'l Alliance on Mental Health

Theresa Bomhof serves NAMI Greater Des Moines as Vice-President & Editor of Newsletter & Legislative Lead and has performed all leadership positions in the organization. NAMI is a self-help, support and advocacy education, organization dedicated to improving the lives of families who have relatives with a brain disorder (mental illness). The National Alliance on Mental Illness was founded in 1979 by 2 mothers in Wisconsin who met, discovering that each had a child with severe mental illness. They shared a frustration at the health system's care for their children and great hurt from a society who shunned them. Since that time, the organization has grown from 254 members to over a quarter million.

Theresa shared her personal experiences with her son's and daughter's mental illness and related a number of facts regarding mental illness. In many cases it is a best kept secret within families few like to talk about it. Mental illness predominately (75% of cases) strikes the 15-25 age groups.

NAMI is about support, information and education. One of four families is affected by mental illness during a lifetime. Treatment can produce a 70-90% success rate. NAMI needs volunteers and funds to help the individual and families to learn and cope.
