Wendi Wilson

Friday's speaker may have volunteered to help combat podium withdraw. Wendi earned her BS degree from Graceland in 1988 then completed her degree in optometry at Indiana University in 1992. Upon graduation and returning to Iowa, Wendi served in Ankeny, Altoona, and Beaverdale, then located at her present location on 86th Street. During her first 3 years of undergraduate study, Wendi considered the OBGYN specialty. Realizing that this could interfere with family life, and after a visit to her optometrist, she began studies towards an optometric degree.

Her presentation started with anatomy of the eye and a discussion on cataracts, causes, and symptoms. Long term exposure to ultraviolet light is a major cause, along with certain medications. Not unusual at age 60+. Symptoms include sensitivity to light, weakened night time vision, and sometimes deterioration in color vision. Lens replacement/implant is a common Modern technique and solution. equipment can accomplish this in an 8 hour surgery.

Macular degeneration results from a break down of retinal cells disturbing central vision and resulting in difficulty in reading, distorted and blurred vision. This normally starts after age 50 and is sometimes caused by vascular disease, head injury, long-term sun exposure, smoking, and high blood pressure.
