Attending weekly club meetings allows members to enjoy fellowship, enrich their professional and personal knowledge, and meet other business leaders in their community.

If members miss a meeting, they're encouraged to expand their Rotary horizons by attending a meeting of any other Rotary club in the world.

A club member must attend or make up at least 50 percent of regular club meetings in each half of the year (though some clubs may have more stringent requirements). Any missed meetings must be made up within 14 days of a regular meeting. If traveling, club members are

encouraged to visit clubs in the new area to make up a missed meeting.

Rotarians often wonder what to do if there's not a club where they travel or if an emergency causes them to miss a meeting. One option is to participate in an interactive


