Iowa Hospice

The NW Des Moines Rotary welcomed Eddie Erlbacher from Iowa Hospice as our speaker. Iowa Hospice is one of five hospice organizations in Iowa . "The philosophy of hospice care is to provide expert and compassionate physical, emotional, and spiritual support for those who are dying and their families."

Hospice eligibility can be determined by physician or a family can request a hospice evaluation to see if a family member is eligible. Hospice is for people no longer seeking curative treatment and need assistance for their end of life period. In general, hospice care is reserved for anyone with a life limiting or

terminal prognosis of six months or less to live.

Iowa Hospice does not own a hospice house. It provides hospice care wherever it is needed. Often times this is in a nursing home or the patient's residence. Iowa Hospice is a for profit company that provides medical, home health, short term inpatient, and continuous home care. In addition, they provide massage and music therapy as well emotional and spiritual support.

Hospice care is paid for in full by Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance. Hospice is paid \$147 per day to provide all care and medications. However no one is ever turned away due the inability to pay.

Success breeds success.


Maintain your momentum by reminding yourself how far you've come and by focusing on the small steps ahead - and the rewards. Try this:
