for the 2009 Bullhead City River Regatta — and the Bullhead City Rotary Club is really in the thick of it this year!! The theme of this year's Regatta, celebrating Bullhead City's 25th birthday, is "Birthday Bash - N - Splash." <u>Every member</u> of our Rotary Club and Interact Club who can possibly be on hand at Rotary Park to help, from 8:00 - 4:00 on Saturday, August 29th, will be needed!

The floating entries in this year's River Regatta begin launching from Community Park at 7:30 AM. Most of the participants will park their vehicles at Rotary Park very early that morning, and take the Regatta Shuttle to the launch site. It generally take 3-4 hours to navigate the 8 miles of the Colorado River down to Rotary Park, where we will be set up to serve the floaters and their families & friends as they arrive. As the floaters disembark from their journey down-river, Rotary is in charge of feeding the expected 5,000-plus paid registrants for this year's event with a hot dog, chips and a can of soda. The cost of the lunch is included in their registration fee. In addition, we will be coordinating the exhibitors & vendors and will be offering soft drinks and water for sale.
