In addition, we will be offering fountain soft drinks and water for sale to the families, friends and other spectators — which could be another 2,000 - 3,000.

Stephanie Moore, who is heading up our food service operation, says, "We need 'All Hands on Deck' on Satuday, August 29th. Plan to put in a days work 8-5 to help our club make some much needed money. If we do a great job, we will be the front runner for the 'job' next year. This is a wonderful opportunity for our club, let's really commit to making it a success. Shirin says, "Everyone in the club should plan on working the day of the event. Everyone with food handler permits will be needed in the food delivery area and the soda booth. Those without the permits will be needed to run the bouncy castle and to assist the company with the water rides.
