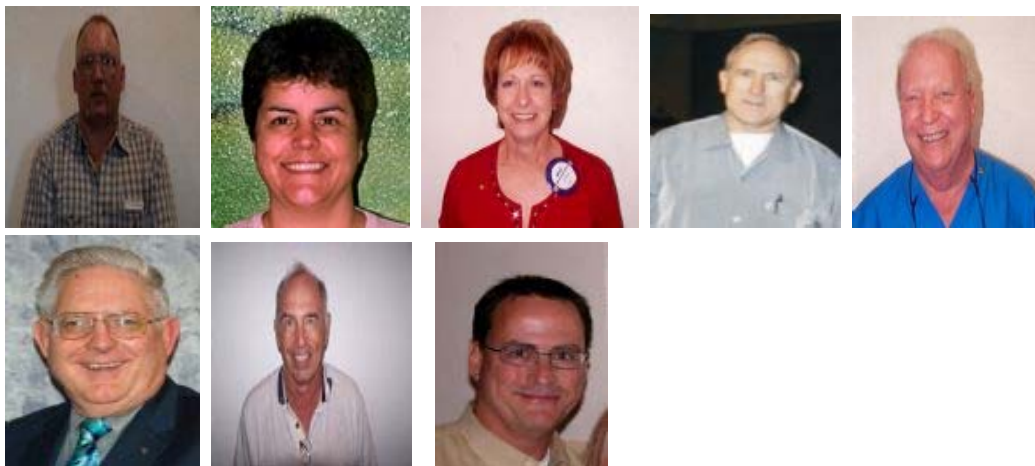

Rotary Continues to Change

RI Council on Legislation makes changes in Rotary



The recently-completed Rotary International Council on Legislation, which meets every 3 years, with representation from Rotary districts around the world,

enacted a number of changes in the way Rotary will function. These changes include:

- The office of Immediate Past President was created for all Rotary clubs.
- Rotary e-Clubs were officially approved, with 2 e-Clubs permitted per district.
- A Fifth Avenue of Service was created: New Generations.
- Set a minimum age 65 for eligibility for the so-called Rule of 85 for excused absences. The 85 refers to the aggregate of a member's age and years of membership in Rotary.
- Require transferring members to provide a certificate from the board of their previous club confirming prior membership.
- Increased RI dues \$1 per capita.

November 18-22 - USA/Mexico Friendship Conference and Wheelchair Distribution

We have just received word that there will be a combination USA/Mexico Friendship Conference and Wheelchair Distribution November 18-22, 2010. (Thursday, the 18th, and Monday, the 22nd will be travel days.) The trip will include Puebla, Cuernavaca, Cholula and other destinations in Mexico's District 4180.

Details about group travel arrangements and reasonably priced hotel rooms will be coming shortly. There is a possibility for some home hosting, as well.

The USA/Mexico Conference will focus on projects, matching grants, simplified grants, fellowship and friendship.

The Rotary clubs of our District 5490 have committed significant funding for wheelchairs, and one container of 280 wheelchairs will be distributed on this trip. The district will be sending additional wheelchairs to Haiti and other locations in 2011, obtaining the wheelchairs through the Wheelchair Foundation.
