Communities in Schools WeekEND Hunger Program

Our thanks to Bernadette Pires for bring us an outstanding program regarding the local Communities in Schools service at our club meeting last Thursday.

We would note that our Interact Club at Mohave High has sponsored a child through this program during this past school year.

For many local homeless and at-risk children, the free lunches they eat at school are the only meals they have all week. And they have little or nothing to eat on weekends. That is why Bernadette started the "WeekEND Hunger Program." Children in need are sent home with a backpack full of food on Friday to get them through the weekend. They return the empty packs, and they are filled again for them during the week.

Bernadette says the schools are reporting major improvements in the children's school performance and their attitudes and self-esteem, due their assistance through this program.

Both food and monetary contributions can be made to the program. A child can be sponsored for only \$30 per month. 100% of each donation is used to buy food for these local children. Checks can be made payable to "Communities in Schools" and mailed to 2541 Fox Run Lane, Bullhead City, AZ 86442. The Mohave Credit Union, in the K-Mart Center, is a drop point for food and monetary contributions.

Recommended Foods: Tuna, Ravioli, Fruit Cups, Vienna Sausages, Pudding Cups, Beans-n-Franks, Small Cereal Boxes, Milk-n-Cereal Bars, Juice Boxes, Peanut Butter Crackers, Cheese Crackers, Granola Bars and Nuts. *Cans must have pop-lids.*
