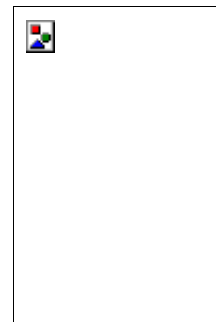
INTERACT CLUB KAYAK TRIP
