

**The Rotary Foundation has** announced that 51,305 new Paul Harris Fellows were added during the 2005-06 Rotary year. That brings the total number of PHFs by the end of the year to 1,011,551.

Here's how the contributions to our Rotary Foundation for the year looked:

• Annual Programs Fund \$92.6 million

• Permanent Fund \$12.1 million

PolioPlus Fund \$ 5.6 million

• Other \$ 1.6 million

• Total Contributions: \$111.9 million
