The answer to last week's question is found in the Club Bylaws, **Article 3, "Election of Directors and Officers"** 

**Section 4** "A vacancy in the board or any office shall be filled by action of the remaining directors."

**Section 5** "A vacancy in the position of any officer-elect or director-elect shall be filled by the action of the remaining directors-elect."

Using the club governing documents to find answers is the best way to make sure decisions made are "fair to all concerned."
