### PRESENTATION: Jaye Lene Long: Hope Fest/Honor & Remember

Jaye Lene Long, a Texas native, born into a military family moved to the Prescott area in 1990 so her sons could know the adventures and memories of growing up in the country. Upon reaching adulthood, each of her sons pursued careers in the military. Sadly, these decisions resulted in the deaths of her twin sons due to trauma experienced during their service. This loss moved Jaye Lene to become a community relations cultivator & advocate with several local groups representing veterans, first responders, behavioral health professionals and domestic violence prevention organizations. These efforts resulted in the creation of the Hope Fest and Honor & Remember programs. The mission of Hope Fest is to serve veterans, active military, first responders & families throughout Yavapai County. For 10 years the Hope Fest program has provided education, housing, recovery, domestic violence, suicide prevention & veteran/first responder family services to this vulnerable demographic. The Honor & Remember program serves to perpetually recognize the sacrifice of America's military fallen service members and their families. The Honor & Remember Flag is the symbol of remembrance created to memorialize these fallen service members. **THANK YOU FOR TRANSFORMING INSUFFERABLE LOSS INTO A HOPE FILLED FUTURE.**
