### **Presentation: Missy Sikora: Yavapai Family Advocacy Center (YFAC)**

Missy Sikora serves as the YFAC Director. As director, she serves as/on the county Children's Justice Coordinator, the Board of Directors for the Yavapai CASA for Kids Foundation & co-chairs the Yavapai County (YC) Multi-Disciplinary Task Force. She is a member of the YC Child Fatality & Overdose Review Teams. She shared that, "she came from a long line of law enforcement officers," which contributed to developing a perspective that many of her clients are victims of generational trauma & that the state (correction/probation) systems are not set up to provide good quality care for victims of all ages." She emphasized, "children need quality care to heal while developing self worth & avoid being (re)victimimized during by investigative processes."
