She is a member of the YC Child Fatality & Overdose Review Teams. She shared that, "she came from a long line of law enforcement officers," which contributed to developing a perspective that many of her clients a victims of generational trauma & that the state (correction/probation) systems are not set up to provide good quality care for victims of all ages." She emphasized, "children need quality care to heal while developing self worth & avoid being (re)victimized during by investigative processes."
