### Speaker: Robert Wertz: How I Became a Peacebuilder & Rotarian

Robert shared personal anecdotes that outlined experiences that contributed to his work as a peacebuilder & Rotarian. Beginning with a near death experience, during which he envisioned a service based life, he shared how creative expression contributed to this new way of living. His introduction to labyrinths formed the foundation for a program entitled, Paths to Peace (P2P). The P2P program employs an unconventional labyrinth based on the Jewish Star of David. In 2011, the P2P program was introduced to the PF Rotary Club which resulted in the formation of a Rotary Peacebuilder Club. Through the support of the PFCF, the club has facilitated the creation of several Prescott based Peace Poles & established a Peace Essay Scholarship. Robert extended an invitation to any member interested in nurturing peace throughout our community & abroad.
