ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Mike Payson reported on the food sorting community project to help Community Cupboard. We had a great turn out to sort a 60 foot truck. 15 or 16 of our members were present to help. Upcoming community events will be forthcoming.
- President Mary Fusinski will be continuing to send out notifications for available Covid-19 vaccinations as she is sent them from her physician.

PRESENTATION:

Last month the club donated \$5,000 to several local food banks. 2 recipients spoke.

Bob Wilson - Yavapai Food Bank: Currently in the food program they do 70 boxes a day 4 days a week feeding 560 people a day. They put together what is a designed "Balanced Box". They have a box that is based on age. They also distribute hygiene products. Razors, tooth brushes and paste, etc. They no longer provide clothing except for coats as they are needed. 1600 School backpacks for schools were also provided. They are open Tues-Friday and trucks run 7 days a week picking up donated items. They operate on only 5% of financial donations. They are primarily a volunteer organization. They serve County Wide. 40 lbs of food for 2 people in a box. Due to community generosity their facility is completely paid for.

Capt. Tony Poe - Salvation Army: We were thanked for \$761 raised from our bell ringing during the holidays as well as our \$5,000 donation. They have an "Operation DEEP FREEZE" program where they offer shelter for nights that drop below freezing. They feed and provide shelter. Last year that program they spent \$29k. They provide breakfast for those in need. In the summer they serve up to 200 people a day. They hand out food from a truck and also run a truck to pickup food donations. Salvation Army started in Prescott in 1893. They are expanding services to Chino Valley including clothing to help with the large number of homeless children there. With donated money they are hosting 50 kids for a 3 day camp.
