Announcements:

The Sgt-at-Arm: Earl Moss as our Sgt-at-Arms extracted fines on an array of subjects and gathered Happy Bucks.

Presentation: Noel De Sousa - Assistant Governor District 5495

Noel addressed several subjects. The first was the Service Trip to Caborca, Mexico. Originally the trip was to distribute polio drop vaccine to children. Now additionally they are to support the Caborca Childrens' Medical Fund and work on Foundation grants for the area. Recent Global Grants have provided clean water tanks for the villages and a new fully equipped Medical Van providing prenatal and pediatric services for the rural areas. The next project will work on providing a pediatric wing for the Caborca Hospital. We have completed the grant project for the Yarnell Water system and are working on school fountains for Rocky Point. At \$125 per member our club contributes approximately \$5K a year through our individual dues. So far this year we have sent over \$6K in pledges to the Foundation.
