The club is planning a weekend filled with fun events to benefit Big Park School's International Baccalaureate program, Tee Up Fore Team Big Park.

Festivities begin with the Sip & Savor Reception and Live & Silent Auction Friday, **October 6** at the Collective's Vista Hall. The event will feature a Live Auction (African Safari, Food and Wine Pairing Dinners, Helicopter Rides and Ski Resort Lodging), a Silent Auction with a variety of items from our regional vendors, catering by J Wine Bistro, wine donated by Chateau Ste. Michelle, and keyboard performances by our own Village pianist Joe Bongiorno.

Event organizers are working hard to ensure that the event will be a Zero Waste event, consistent with the students' education in principles of sustainability. The PTSA of Big Park Community School will be hosting a "Kids Night In" at the school with pizza and a movie or craft projects from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m., so parents and teachers are able to attend the Party at Vista Hall. The \$50 per person price includes food and beverages and raffle tickets.

On Saturday, **October 7** from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. events continue at the Sedona Golf Resort Driving Range. There will be car shows by the Arizona Outlaw 345 Porsche Club and the Sedona Car Club. There will be putting contests for both adults and children under 12 with great prizes, a BBQ, and a bouncy house for children. The highlight of the day will be the Helicopter Ball Drop, (helicopter donated by Sedona Helicopter Tours). Balls will sell for \$5 each with your special number on the ball, \$20 for 5 balls. When the balls are dropped, the one in the hole will receive \$1,000 cash.
