### Secretary's Report: Edward Peterson

- There was no meeting in July.
- Brandon Elliott stated that he would bring up the open board positions at the next meeting and make a request for volunteers to fill the openings. To date, Emilia Alonso-Sameno has been unable to recruit anyone.
- We will be adding 5 new members during the next month. A corporate membership with Snider Fuller and Stroh and two individual memberships.
- The next new-member orientation will be held on September 30st. from 5pm to 8pm at Mike Noel's house. Food will be provided, menu undecided.

#### <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: **Dave Diggle**

- Treasurer's Reports are attached.
- Dave Diggle reported that the current Budget vs. Actual shortfall of \$1,041.69 will be covered when the outstanding Member Accounts (\$1,517.50) are collected.
- The Budget for Fiscal Year 2018-19 shows a short fall of \$3,351.50. Dave Diggle proposed that this can be eliminated by reducing the contribution to Athens Rotary Foundation by \$1,000 and eliminating the Conference Reimbursement . This is possible due to Tom Gibbs agreeing that he would not be attending the next RI conference in Germany. Dave Diggle made motion to accept this plan which was seconded by Mike Noel. Unanimous approval was given with the caveat that it could be revisited if circumstances permitted.
- Dave Diggle reported that the lunch contract with the OU Inn has been renegotiated; from now on, the Inn will set tables for 48 down from 54 also, the "potato bar" has been eliminated from the rotation. The cost for the lunch has remained unchanged. When a significantly larger turnout (+6) is anticipated, it will be necessary to advise the Inn as soon as possible so that additional places can be set. For example, when the football coach talks there is usually a larger crowd.
