# Athens Rotary Club Board Meeting Minutes Wednesday February 7, 2018 11:30 AM Ohio University Inn, Wilson Room

#### Call to Order: Michael Noel @ 11:45

• Members present: Mike Noel, Edward Peterson, Dave Diggle, Sheila Mark, Tara Gilts, Tom Gibbs and Emilia Alonso-Sameño

### Secretary's Report: Edward Peterson

- There are no January Board meeting minutes. Due to weather and travel there were not enough in attendance for a quorum.
- Report on Crutches for Africa
  - Mike Noel reported that \$530 was raised at the Holiday Party to help defray the cost to ship the crutches to Africa.
  - We are still anticipating Interact clubs involvement with collecting crutches.
  - As for now Mike Noel will continue to store what has been collected at his home.
  - o Sheila Mark donated a walker at the meeting and gave it to Mike Noel.
- Fred and Nedra Zirkle have sent a letter to the club with their resignation. Mike Noel read the letter and gave it to Ed Peterson. It was decided to discuss their reasons for resigning at the Visioning session. Ed Peterson will remove them from the membership roles once their prepaid membership dues expire on 6/30/18.
- Jane Woodrow's leave of absence request was proposed by Dave Diggle and seconded by Emilia Alonso-Sameno and received unanimous approval.
- Meal costs were discussed as a barrier to new, younger members. It was agreed to include this in the Visioning session.
- It was discussed to have a member of the Sunrise Rotary at our Visioning session to discuss common barriers to membership and potential joint marketing of both clubs with each focusing on a particular demographic.

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### Treasurer's Report: Dave Diggle

- Dave Diggle recommended that Calvin James, in his role as the TRF Chair, should be asked to "talk up" donations stressing the \$100/Yr/Rotarian program.
- Dave Diggle requested a thank you card be circulated and sent to Sarah Baker for her efforts to ensure all TRF donations were accounted for and could be included in the donor's tax returns.
- Dave Diggle raised the case of Chuck Atkins, a long time Rotarian, who has not been attending meetings due to health issues. He recommended, that as a special case, Chuck Atkins could attend meetings and when not eating due to his physical limitations not be charged for a meal. After discussion Ed Peterson made the proposal, Dave Diggle seconded and it was unanimously approved. Dave Diggle will contact Chuck Atkins and ensure that he is aware of the option. This will be offered to members in good standing on a case by case basis with approval of the board.

#### Vocational Service Report: Tom Gibbs

- Greeters and Invocations have been difficult to sign up. Not having greeters was seen as a reflection on the club's lack of a welcoming environment.
- Tara Gilts that she will be taking a break from Rotary for July to October in order to have a baby.
