12:05-12:20 Financials Dave Diggle

Dave Diggle reviewed the status of several members in anticipation of RI dues invoice. Ed Peterson took as an action to update all 3 membership data bases.

Dave Diggle commented that our Kroger dollars have been declining. Brandon Elliott took an action to review the process of linking your Kroger card to the Athens Rotary at our next club meeting.

Dave Diggle pointed out on the Budget vs. Actual that our Meals income was on target when the Holiday Party receipts are included.

Brandon Elliott reported that he is now set up with signature authority to sign checks, related to our international service grant, to provide water filters for schools in India.

Mike Noel/All

Mike Noel reported that he has delivered the collected crutches and walkers to 'Crutches for Africa'. He is still collecting money to defray the shipping costs. Money donated during the 'Silent Auction' at the Holiday Party was to go toward the shipping costs. To date, some of the prizes have not been paid for; so, he is continuing to contact the auction winners.

Brandon Elliott reported that the club has been turned down by the city on our request to close Court Street on 'Mom's Weekend' for our Pizza Fest. He will continue to negotiate with the city for another date that has fewer conflicts or another location off Court St. Brandon Elliott expects to form a small committee to hash out alternatives, with the city, over the next 2 weeks. This may include sharing a portion of the receipts with the city.

Brandon Elliott reported that a 'GoFundMe' account has been set up to fund the 'Clean Hands' project in the elementary schools that are currently serviced by Athens School District's vendor. This will exclude Nelsonville schools who use a different vendor. The vendor has agreed to provide the dispensers, and the club will pay for the sanitizer. The estimated cost for 1 year is \$3,000-\$4,000. This will be covered by a \$1,000 District Grant and money from the GoFundMe account (\$1,500 target). All remaining funds would come from the Pizza Fest.

Tara Gilts talked about a potential upcoming club social at Nelsonville Pottery located in the Nelsonville Emporium on the Square. Tara Gilts also mentioned the Athens Museum as a venue. Plans are not yet finalized. Tara Gilts agreed to send out schedule information for the upcoming social events.

Mike Noel mentioned that the Women's BB Team was playing tonight

against the 16th - ranked team in the nation. Tickets were free. Ed Peterson took an action to send a club-wide email encouraging members to attend the game and form a 'Rotary rooting section'.

Mike Noel reported that a small group has met to discuss the issues raised at the new-member orientation held last November. Dan Smith has been looking into alternatives to create more interest among younger, potential members. One idea raised was to have younger members, up to 35 years old, qualify for a 'meal rebate' when they attend a meeting. The idea is to pay the full meal cost and then receive a partial rebate on the meals they attended.
