Riverhead Rotary Scholarship ~ \$8,000 award paid \$2,000 per year. Outstanding academic achievement, community service, extracurricular activities, and financial need.

Tara J. Malanga Memorial Scholarship ~ \$4,000 paid \$1000 per year for 4 years varsity sports participation (special emphasis on basketball or lacrosse) community service, A or B average, financial need.
